Discount Policy and Late Fee:

- 1. Registration fee of \$25 is waived if enrolling before 5/31.
- 2. A 10% discount* is available for 2nd or more children in the same family for summer camp only (applied to the lower tuition).
- 3. 10% discount* is offered for students who participates in the whole summer program (10 weeks, but not cumulative with other discount. It does not apply to pre-school and Junior K summer quarter).
- 4. Full tuition must be paid one week (7 days) before the camp starts. Otherwise, a \$10 late fee is charged in addition to the registration fee and full tuition.
